As a parent/guardian of a player in the Mt. Airy Football Program, I hereby certify that I will abide by the governing principles set forth in this Parents Code of Conduct. I recognize that my conduct and participation is an essential component of a successful season for each of our young players.

My commitment is to:

- Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other Mt. Airy Football or Mountain Valley League events.
- Place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- Insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- Support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- Demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all Mt. Airy Football or Mountain Valley League events.
- Remember that the game is for youth-not for adults.
- Do my very best to make Mt. Airy Football fun for my child.
- Ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials, with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- Promise to help my child enjoy the Mt. Airy experience by doing whatever I can, such as volunteering/performing required duties as assigned and being a respectable fan and good representative of the Mt. Airy Football Program at all times.
- I understand my child's coach has been trained in the responsibilities of being a youth football coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches Code of Conduct.
- Understand that the Mountain Valley League to which Mt. Airy Football is a member is a competitive environment and will do what I can to help the Mt. Airy Football Program implement and enforce the rules and responsibilities placed on Mt. Airy Football by the league.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or Parent/Coach Liaison
- Written warning
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file
- Parental season suspension
